The Start/Staging and Parking are located at Loudon Elementary School in Loudon, NH. See directions below.

## DIRECTIONS

Parking and registration will be at the Loudon Elementary School in Loudon, NH. Staging and the start of the race will be located on the corner of School Street and Oak Hill Road. Finish will be on School St.

From the North and South, take I-93N to Exit 15 East. Merge onto I-393 East towards Loudon. Take the Rt. 106 exit on the right. At the end of the ramp, turn LEFT on Rt. 106 North. Follow 106 North for approx. 3 miles. Turn Left onto School St/Rt. 129 at the set of lights. The road bends right, then left. The Loudon Elementary School will be on the left. Follow signs to parking.
